GENERAL WEATHER SYNOPSIS

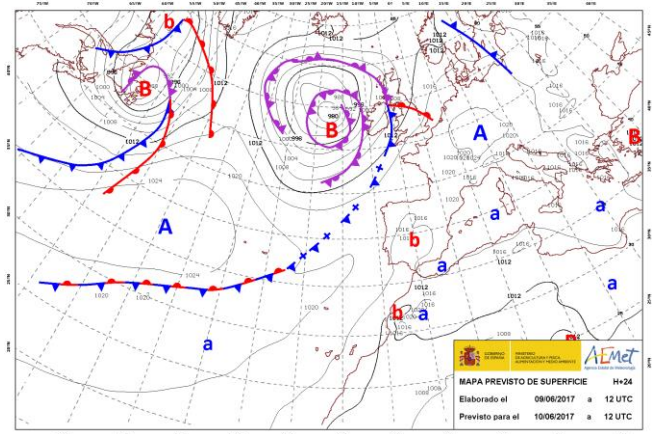
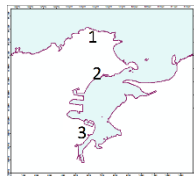
Low 988 W of British Isles moving NNW in the next hours and allowing the pass of a High 1028 centered now over Azores to be more and more influential over the Biscay bay , with a cold front reaching the NW coast of the Iberian Peninsula at the end of the day and then near stationary. A thermal Low pressure center over Spain and Portugal.

Today (10-20h): Sunny with periods of high level cloud cover (Cirrus) in the middle of the day. Good visibility. ENE 2 , backing gradually during the midday then NW-2-3 in the afternoon

OUTLOOK FOR TOMORROW

Cloudy to overcast. High chance of poor visibility because of advective persistent and dense fog banks over the coast, specially in the northern races areas. W to WNW 2-3 temporally 3-4 Beaufort at noon.

Rippled increasing to smooth sea in the morning. NW swell increasing gradually to 1.8 m, 12-13 sec during the day.
