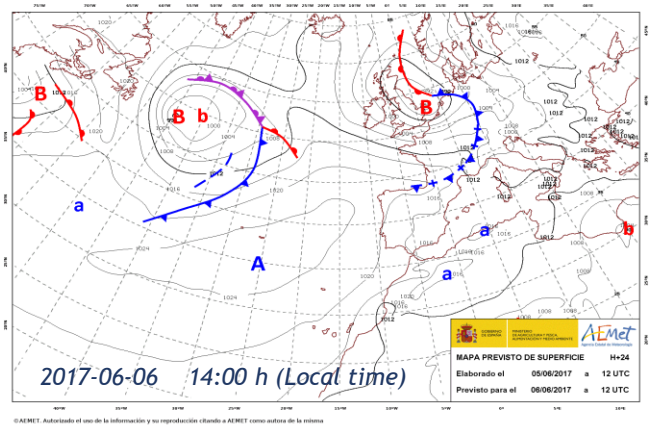


# WEATHER REPORT- Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> JUNE

## GENERAL WEATHER SYNOPSIS

A cold front associated with a low 992 hPa over Great Britain has swept the Biscay Bay and during today a ridge 1020 hPa will gradually extend over the area.

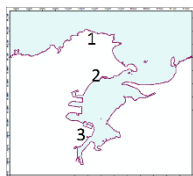
Today (10-20h): Cloudy to overcast with a chance of light rain until midday and likely sunny spells in the afternoon. Good visibility. NW 3-4 winds, gradually decreasing during the afternoon.
