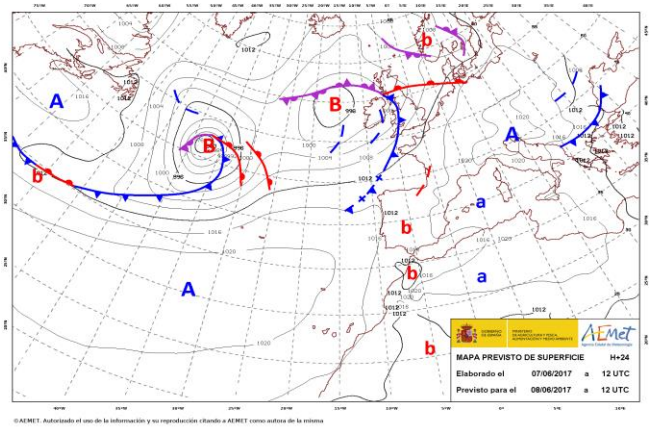


WEATHER REPORT- Thursday 8th JUNE

GENERAL WEATHER SYNOPSIS

Low 996 hPa W of the British Isles, with a cold front reaching the NW coast of the Iberian Peninsula. A high level trough will cross the region during the day, generating instability in the afternoon.

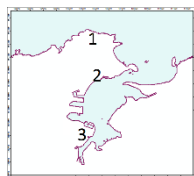
Today (10-20h): A sunny start becoming cloudy in the afternoon, with a chance of showers which could be thundery. Good visibility, moderate under showers. W 4 with intervals of 5, dropping to 2-3 at the end of the period.
