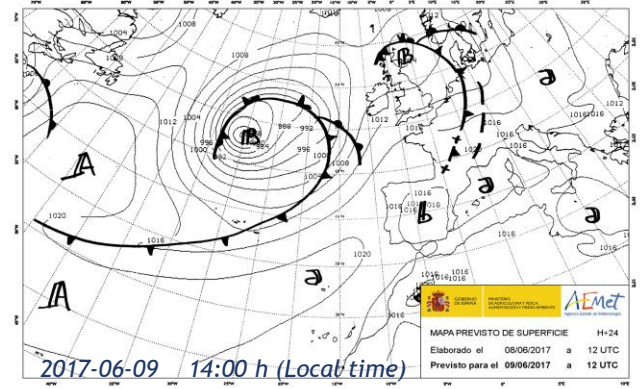


WEATHER REPORT- Friday 9th JUNE

GENERAL WEATHER SYNOPSIS

Low 965 hPa NNW of Azores moving E and gradually filling. Thermal low 1014 hPa over the Iberian Peninsula. High pressure 1020 S of Azores.

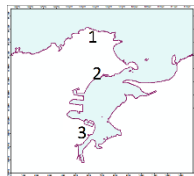
Today (10-20h): Cloudy sky (mainly cirrus). Good visibility. VRB 1-2 (mainly southerly), becoming soon NE 3, occasionally 4 in the northern half.

Rippled sea increasing to smooth in the north during the early afternoon. NW swell 1 m, 9 sec.

Sunny. Good visibility. ENE 2-3 in the southern half and NE 3-4 in the northern half, backing NW 2 during the afternoon.

Rippled sea, smooth in the northern half in the morning. NW swell 1 m, 9 sec.
